While Glen stayed in Oslo to preach and lead Bible studies, Ivy spent 15 days co-leading a STM trip to Thailand and Indonesia. The first part of the mission trip was to train the young Aka (tribal) leaders living in Thailand. The training camp was intensive and never lack of challenges. Due to



communication barriers, our STM team was surprised to learn that almost 1/3 of the camp participants were not Christians yet. Thank God for the creativities and teamwork



among 7 of us (4 from Norway + 3 from Finland), ending the camp with thanksgiving.

On the second part of the mission trip, 4 of us from Norway joined the mission trip hosted by K-Pact to 3 different islands in Indonesia. We served meals to children in the villages, shared testimonies, led a workshop, and preached. Most importantly, we observed and prayed for various mission projects across Indonesia. Please pray for us to see God's will if this is the partnership we should continue.

When ALIVE meets Agape...

There are many churches without a pastor for the Next Gen, and the Nordic Chinese Christian Church in Malmo is no exception. God has given us the vision to extend the love among ourselves to them. Therefore, a visit from ALIVE (the Next Gen in Oslo) to Agape (the fellowship in Malmo) was planned. We spent a weekend together over games, laughter, worship, prayer, and Holy Communion. An encouragement was to see one of the



young men who was struggling with his faith greatly on our last visit to Malmo returned to God in obedience after many online conversations/prayers. Another young man came and prayed with us, he shared with us that it was Ivy's message at last year's Easter Camp which woke him up from a journey to the "wrong" path. We pray that we will continue to empower our young people to make a difference.

With our very limited Norwegian, it has not been easy to network with other churches and organizations. However, just when we reached the threshold, we were invited to join the planning committee and speak in a workshop at a cross-cultural, and multi-generational Christian festival in January 2019.
