Keynote Speaker

Rev. Dr. Gordon T. Smith

Gordon T. Smith is President and Professor of Systematic and Spiritual Theology, Ambrose University and Seminary in Calgary, Alberta as of August 2012. He continues to serve as a sessional lecturer with Regent College. He previously served full-time with the Regent faculty as the Academic Dean. He is an ordained minister with the Christian and Missionary Alliance. Dr. Smith is the author of a number of books, including *Transforming Conversion: Rethinking the Language and Contours of Christian Initiation* (Baker Academic, 2010)

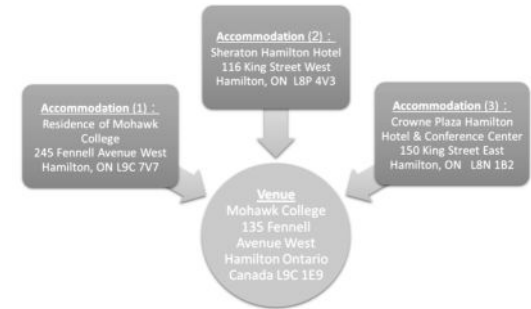
Registration Instruction

- Each family unit needs to complete ONE form only. Same for single applicant.
- In addition to the main form, EACH child under 18 years old is also required to submit the children/youth form.
- Please staple all forms of each family before sending back to CCACA office.
- Please carefully fill in the registration form. Your information is important for the overall accommodation and program arrangement of the convention.
- Please make all cheques payable to "CCACA" with a memo note: "JMC2017".
- Early bird discount is for full-time registration ONLY. Early bird deadline is April 30, 2017.

Full-Time or Part-Time Registration

- Registration deadline is June 30, 2017. As we have to negotiate with hotels for the provision of accommodation, no full-time or part-time registration will be accepted after deadline.

- JMC reserves the right to assign accommodation and meals plan for all full-time and part-time registrants.
- Accommodation will be assigned to hotels or College residence based on your registration information and other factors. We apologize if it doesn't satisfy your preference, but there will be no argument with the arrangement.
- Those who stay in Sheraton, Crown Plaza or Homewood hotels can claim the parking fee during the convention. The details will be announced later. JMC will also be responsible for the parking in Mohawk College.
- Registrants will be informed through emails of their accommodation and program arrangements two weeks before the convention.



Day Campers:

- Day camp is designed for local brothers and sisters. We still encourage participants to register as full-timers as much as possible.
- Day camp registration fee doesn't include accommodation or meal plan. If day campers want to eat with other participants for lunch or supper, they can buy meal tickets in the convention. Please contact CCACA office for more information.
- There is no registration deadline for day campers, but we encourage early registration as it will help the convention with our overall arrangement.
- The charge will be different for pre-convention registration and at-the-door registration, please check registration form for details.

Rules and Regulations

1. Smoking, alcohol, gambling, pornography or illegal substance is not allowed on the premises. Violators can face disciplinary action.
2. All delegates must register and pay the required fee before conference.
3. Apart from the family residence, men are not allowed in women's residence at any time and vice versa.
4. Pictures, video and audio recording is not permitted during the JMC speaking sessions except the designated person assigned by JMC committee.
5. The planning committee reserves the right to suspend the privileges of those delegates who violate any of the above regulations up to and including expulsion from the convention. The decision of the planning committee is final and binding.
6. As guests at Mohawk College, hotels and followers of Jesus, let us reflect Christian conduct in everything we do.

Refund Policy
