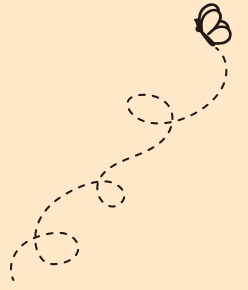
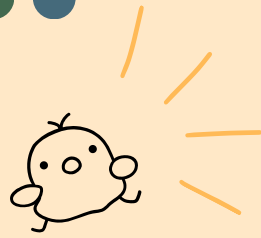

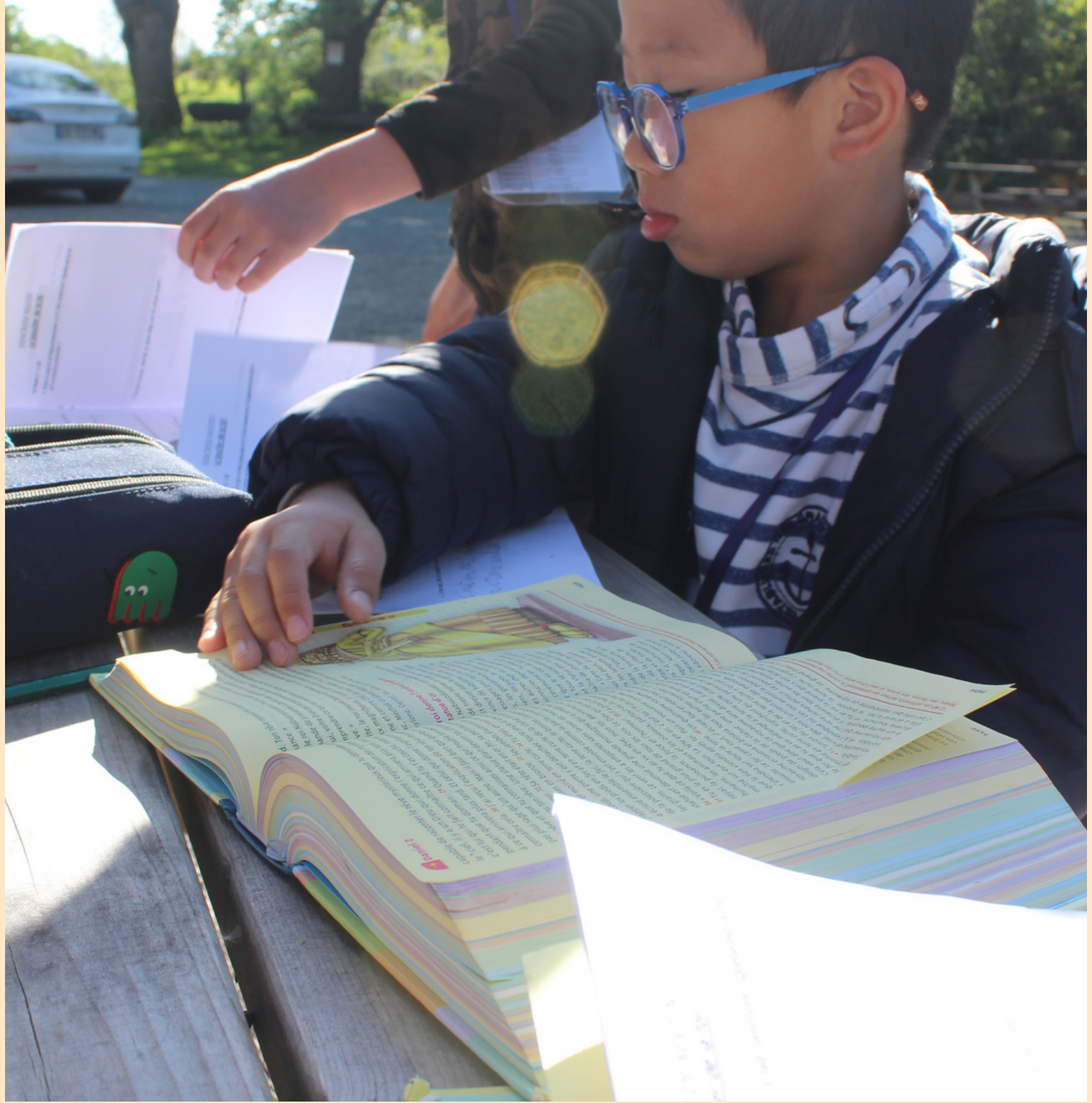


On the last day, each small group presented their Bible Memory Verses in different ways (rap, mime, theatre, dance...)

Bible study was mixed with fun activities to help learn and understand the Bible theme: Armor of God



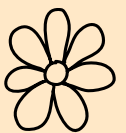

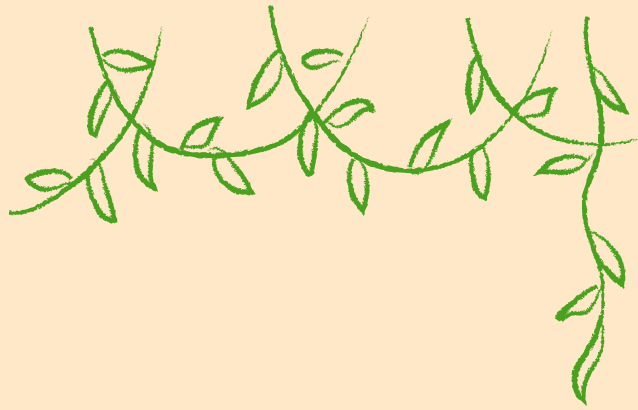
The children showcased their creative talents on the last banquet night.

During these personal exchanges, the children were given the freedom to share anything they wished and to ask questions.

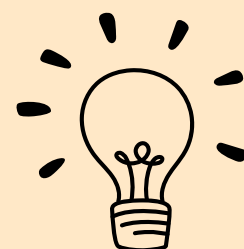
We took the opportunity to ask each child whether they were ready to take the step to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

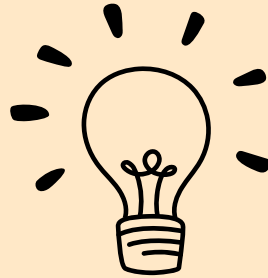
Leading a child to Christ (one on one moment)

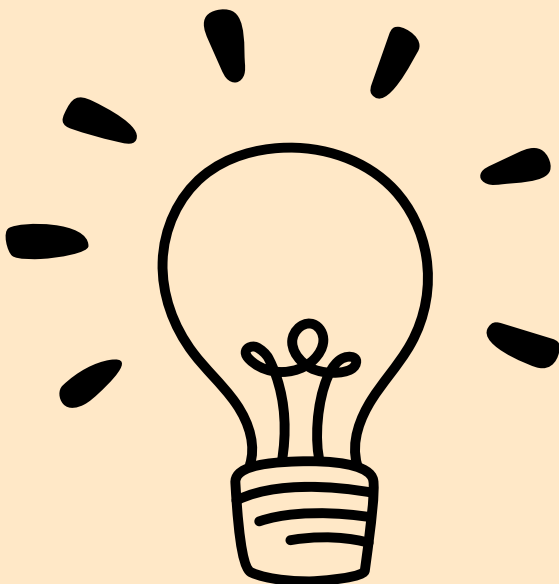
This experience for me (Pascale) was eye-opening, as it not only taught me how to lead a child to Christ but also revealed the deep hunger children possess to know more about Christ, the Gospel, and the complexities of faith. 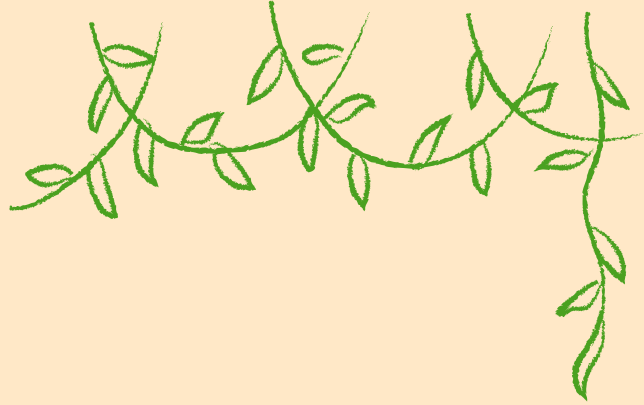

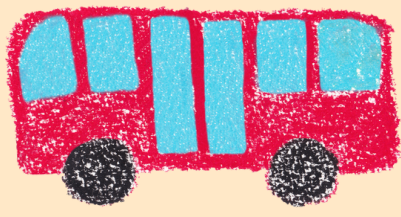
post-camp, teachers followed up with the children's parents -- to let parents know how their child was growing spiritually
