Position Summary

MCAC is looking for an experienced Mandarin Ministry Assistant Pastor to shepherd the Mandarin-speaking members to passionately love God, love one another and to reach the lost in our community and beyond. The pastor is to lead in the development of a specific vision, with goals and objectives, for the Mandarin ministry that is consistent with the overall vision, mission statement, core values and strategic plan of MCAC.

Ministry Responsibilities

- Provide spiritual leadership to the Mandarin ministry leadership team and Mandarin congregation. This includes giving guidance on vision, strategic direction and planning.
- Provide clear biblical teaching and application that leads members to love God, love others and reach the lost.
- Establish healthy spiritual growth of members by:
 - o Counselling members to care for their emotional and spiritual needs.
 - O Discipling them to grow in a transforming relationship with Jesus through an intentional discipleship plan that leads them to maturity.
